SUMMARY

Software engineer with 12 years building and operating web platforms at enterprise scale. At Salesforce/Tableau I share ownership of the build, test, deployment, and reliability automation behind tableau.com — a top-5,400 global site at roughly 13 million monthly visits, on a ~60-module enterprise Drupal platform. I led its Google Analytics 4 (GA4) data-layer re-platform and built its public pricing calculator. I take the release rotation, lead the weekly operations review, and carry the pager.

PLATFORM & INFRASTRUCTURE

- Co-own and have spent four years streamlining an inherited Continuous Integration / Continuous Deployment (CI/CD) system: five purpose-built CI container images in a private registry, a Docker Compose environment running a ~100-spec end-to-end suite deterministically, and branch-scoped dependency cache keys that eliminated a class of intermittent build failures.
- Maintain a gated multi-environment deployment pipeline with commit-SHA parity verification and a programmatic gate blocking production on failed upstream checks — shipping four unattended production releases per week.
- Maintain a nightly Extract-Transform-Load (ETL) pipeline that clones, prunes, and sanitizes production data into test and development, publishes fixtures, and provisions test users.

PRODUCT & ANALYTICS ENGINEERING

- Built the current Tableau Pricing Calculator (tableau.com/product-and-pricing-selector) — a React application on a Drupal REST API I designed, with multi-currency logic and exchange-rate caching server-side, an accessible responsive interface, and end-to-end Cypress coverage.
- Led the GA4 data-layer re-platform — 10+ event types with custom deduplication and consent-compliant cookie management. Effectively every marketing conversion event measured on the property flows through it.
- Authored the technical architecture document for a bulk content-ingestion system processing up to 100 nodes per operation, and led implementation end to end.
- Contributing engineer on the multi-year re-platform from Drupal onto a consolidated enterprise WordPress multisite with a decoupled Node.js frontend — content transformation, Terraform-managed environments, GraphQL integration, and CDN phased-release cutover.

RELIABILITY & RELEASE OWNERSHIP

- Serve as Release Engineer of record on rotation and lead the weekly Operations Review — owning production deployment coordination, change-request sign-off, post-deployment triage, and stakeholder-facing reporting on site health and production errors.
- Authored the team's on-call working agreement — drafted, socialized, and adopted organization-wide within a quarter. Active on-call participant.
- Led real-time investigation of a production incident affecting ~3,000 users: structured log-based impact assessment, root cause traced to a missing build artifact in a gated storage bucket, resolution coordinated with release engineering.
- Onboarded a new engineer onto the platform — authored the onboarding guide and paired through their first pull requests. It became standard for subsequent hires.

- Migrated portions of moz.com from CakePHP to Craft CMS with the Inbound Engineering team, and partnered with UX to translate design comps into marketing pages.

Open-source framework that makes AI coding agents reliable across sessions: persistent structured memory, enforced process workflows, a task lifecycle engine, and a git hook layer enforcing secret scanning and Conventional Commits. Bats test suite in continuous integration; validated on a multi-contributor production platform. Grew out of **LaudBot**, an AI-powered interactive resume delivered across 100+ pull requests.

Beacon Essentials — production e-commerce platform

Designed, built, and maintain the platform end to end. FastAPI / Python 3.11 with async MongoDB, Next.js 14, and a mobile workspace in a Turborepo monorepo — WhatsApp deep-link checkout with Mobile Money integration, order tracking, an admin dashboard, S3 pre-signed media, and GitHub Actions continuous deployment to DigitalOcean. Over one year: 540+ commits and 450+ pull requests, with CI-enforced linting, pytest and Vitest suites, and secret scanning on every commit.

Designed, built, deployed, and maintain a CRM for community-based church programs: authentication, reporting with dynamic search, notifications, messaging, events calendar, and a complete store, cart, and checkout flow over REST APIs.
